

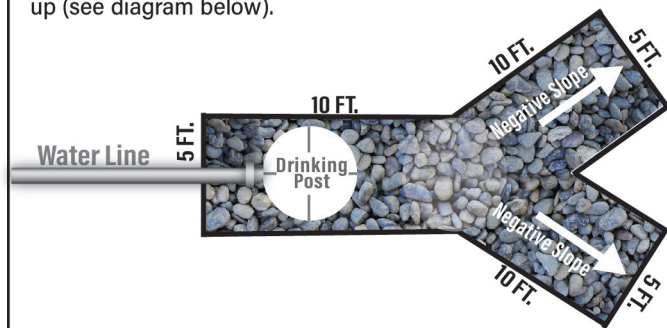


Cold Climate Installation

For installation in cold climates (areas with a frost line depth below 50"), there are some extra steps you can take to ensure proper functioning of your Drinking Post.

1. Install a wider leach field

Dig your leach field in a "Y" shape. Dig each of your pits with a negative grade sloping away from the Drinking Post. Each section of the pit should be 10' long, depending on your set up (see diagram below).



2. Install a hard foam insulation board around the Drinking Post

Installing a hard foam insulation board is a great way to prevent frost during hard freezes. We recommend Owens Corning R-13 hard foam board. Cut it to a 8' x 4' square with an 8" hole in the center for the Drinking Post. This will be placed over the Drinking Post and will sit 30" above the bottom (see diagram).
