



How does it work?

The Drinking Post functions and installs like a frost-free hydrant. The magic of the Drinking Post is that it fills and drains with each use. The unit is completely empty when it's not in use, so it can't freeze or grow algae! Your thirsty animal will walk up to the empty bowl and push the paddle. The bowl will start to fill immediately with fresh water from your pressurized waterline. When they're done drinking, they'll release the paddle and all the water will drain away. The water drains away completely into a leach field below the Post. Your animals will have constant access to fresh, clean water and you won't have any tough watering chores!

Choosing a size

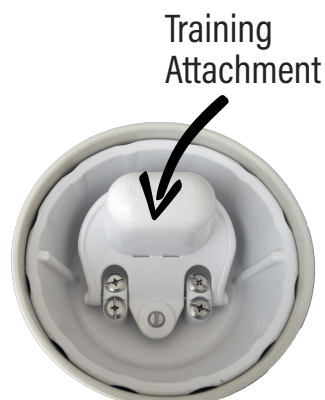


We sell many different sizes, from 2' to 10' long. This means you can get the perfect size for your specific climate and the size of your animals. The base of the Post must sit 18" below the local frost line, and the bowl should be about equal to your animals' shoulder height. If you have multiple species, you want to size it for the shortest animal. Figuring out your frost line depth is the most important aspect of sizing. If you don't know your frost line depth, call a local outdoor plumber or excavator. Your local Dealer can also help you with sizing.

Training



Training is very easy - less is more! Your Post will come with a Training Attachment that makes pushing the paddle easy. You'll take away other water sources and do 1 training session per day. Wait until they're thirsty, bring them up to the Post, and fill the bowl for them - that's it! Avoid pushing the paddle for them more than 1x per day. Some animals will learn right away, and others will take a few days. Molasses is an excellent training aid, put some under the paddle after your daily training session. What's the price?

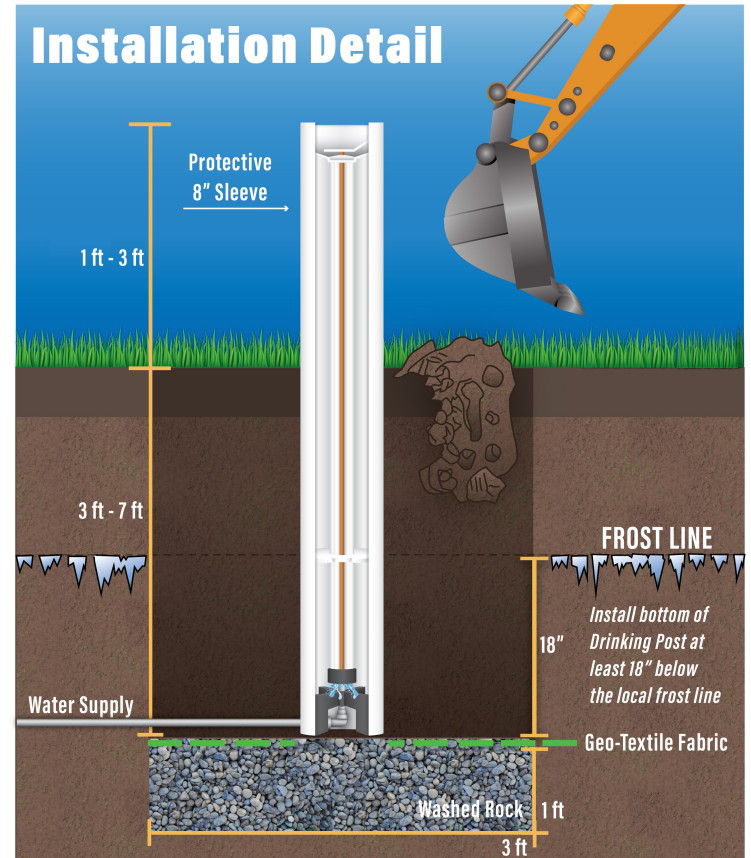

Installation



Installing your Drinking Post is very easy! The installation is very similar to a frost-free hydrant, which any outdoor plumber or excavator will have experience with. They can apply their knowledge of frost-free hydrants directly to the Drinking Post. The two most important parts of installation are (1) making sure the base sits at least 18" below the local frost line, and (2) making sure the leach field is big enough. The minimum dimensions of the leach field are 3' x 3' x 1' deep. If you have clay, hard pan, or anything that might cause bad drainage, you'll want to overbuild the leach field. The Drinking Post will be connected directly to a pressurized waterline and it needs 25 - 65 PSI to function properly. You will receive an Installation Guide with your Drinking Post that has the step-by-step instructions for installation.
